This unusually confined estate (in a popular area with four Munros) presents exceptional challenges for stalking, as it is very difficult for hillwalkers to avoid causing disturbance. By agreement with the access authority (Perth & Kinross Council), walkers are being encouraged to plan ahead and walk elsewhere on days when stalking is taking place during the peak stalking season. This arrangement only applies between mid-Sept and 20 Oct, and is on the understanding that these days will be notified at www.chesthill.com and on signs at the Invervar car park and gate. On days when stalking is not taking place (during this period), staying on the ridges, avoiding the corries and going clockwise from Invervar right round the four Munros will help prevent deer from moving off the estate.
